# Marcellus Shale It's Time to Pay Your Fair Share, So We Can Fund Our Schools

enator Hughes and Senator Art Haywood have introduced a bill to tax natural gas drilling in the Marcellus Shale at eight percent and spend the money on public education. It's estimated that this legislation would generate over \$1 billion for public education in less than five years.

Governor Tom Wolf has offered a similar proposal, although his plan calls for a five percent tax. Everyone agrees: It's time to tax the frackers and make them pay their fair share for our children!

"The natural gas shale drillers are some of the richest corporations in the world, and they have not paid their fair share. While everyone else pays their taxes, the Marcellus Shale drillers don't pay any severance tax. It's time they pay up, and when they do, we can send that money to fund our schools!"

## Reading Program Helps Students Read to Succeed!

or the past two summers, over 500 students between first and fifth grade participated in Senator Hughes' "Save Our Skills" summer reading program. The goal was to "Prevent Summer Slide" to insure that students do not fall behind in their reading skills over the summer break.

Numerous studies indicate that reading at grade level is critically important. 74 percent of students who don't read at grade level by the end of third grade have trouble in later grades and drop out without earning a high school diploma.

For four weeks, students were enrolled in free reading classes taught by volunteer teachers. The program was co-sponsored by the Free Library of Philadelphia, Children's Literacy Initiative, School District of Philadelphia, and Tree House Books.





According to the Center for Disease Control, there are 1.2 million people living with HIV in the U.S. There are about 3.2 million who have Hepatitis C.
